Main Street to 400 N

UDOT in conjunction with American Fork City is beginning design work to widen 100 East (*Alpine Highway*) from Main Street to approximately 350 North (and transitioning back to the existing width from 350 N to 400 N). This road widening is necessary to meet increasing traffic demands that are being placed on this street.

Design work for this project is just beginning. The design team will address the space needed for widening of the road to include two travel lanes in each direction with a continuous center turn lane. This eliminates the parking lanes along the sides of the road in order to provide the necessary space for the additional travel lanes.

The existing curb and gutter along both sides of the street, as well as the park strips will be affected by the road widening. It is likely that the curb and gutter on both sides will be moved back to accommodate additional travel lanes.
