

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING UTAH TRANSIT AUTHORITY

RE: August 2017 Service Changes. UTA is proposing several service changes to local bus service in Utah County. A Public Hearing will be held at the location listed below to discuss these proposed changes. The hearing is to gather feedback for changes to routes 807 and 809 mostly in the American Fork and Pleasant Grove areas.

At the hearing, the Utah Transit Authority will provide an opportunity for citizens, private transportation providers, public officials and interested agencies to comment on the proposed changes. To be included as part of the Public Hearing record, all comments must be postmarked or received by UTA no later than June 25, 2017.

THE FORMAT FOR THE PUBLIC HEARINGS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

Open House to review and discuss proposal with UTA representatives; public comment accepted anytime during the Open House.

To assure full participation at the hearing, accommodations for effective communication such as sign language interpreters, printed materials in alternative formats or a language interpreter for non-English speaking participants, must be requested at least five (5) working days prior to the date of the scheduled event. Proposals are as follows:

UTA is proposing several service changes dependent upon operational feasibility and financial limitations. The changes are designed to improve bus routes. Also, some other concerns such as low ridership, timing and routing adjustments need to be made for a more efficient operating local bus system.

- Route 809 a new fixed route local service to be implemented for limited service between Pleasant Grove and American Fork to American Fork FrontRunner Station. The proposed route will run from Pleasant Grove Main Street north to Pleasant Grove's Center Street, west on West State Street to 1300 West, south on 1300 West to Pleasant Grove Blvd, west on Pleasant Grove Blvd to I-15, north on I-15 to 500 East in American Fork, and north on 500 East to State Street in American Fork. The route will then run west on State Street to 300 West, south on 300 West to 200 South and then west on 200 South to the American Fork FrontRunner Station. There will be two trips in the morning going from PG/AF to FrontRunner Station. In the afternoon there will be two trips going from the FrontRunner Station to AF/PG.
- Route 807 will have a slight modification on SR-92. Instead of pulling into the IM Flash business facility, the route is proposed to serve the Oracle, Maritz-CX and Iasis Hospital on the south side of SR-92. The number of trips and the times for the route will not change.
- Due to road construction at Utah Valley University (UVU), some slight modifications will need to be made to routes 807, 840, 841 and 862. These changes are outlined below:
 - - 807 New routing using 800 S north of UVU,
 - 840 New routing using 800 S north of UVU, use north lot in UVU
 - 841 New routing using 800 S north of UVU
 - 862 New routing using 800 S north of UVU
- Other small timing and schedule changes as needed.
- If approved, changes would go into effect on August 13, 2017.
