To Whom It May Concern:

Re: Pressurized Irrigation (P.I.) System Meter Installation

In recent days, the City has received several inquiries and concerns regarding the new Pressurized Irrigation System Meter ordinance. We understand the concerns and are listening to you. In response, we are making the following changes to the implementation of the new ordinance, effective immediately:

- 1) For those lots where the developer has already installed the old meter box (often called a jumbo box), including the hardware inside, and the box has been inspected by the City to ensure compliance with the old detail, the following narrative will apply:
 - a. The jumbo box and hardware will NOT need to be replaced.
 - b. A PI meter will still be required. This meter will be installed by the City at the same time the culinary water meter is set. This will take place after the applicant for service has set up the utility account with the City and paid the required fees.
- 2) For those lots where the jumbo box has not yet been installed, the new detail sent to you in recent days will apply and must be installed prior to the City setting both meters (culinary and PI). This new detail shows the new meter can and the required hardware that must be installed.
