The work permitted herewith shall commence on _____ and shall diligently be prosecuted to completion. The work shall be completed and all surfaces or objects restored on or before _____. (AF Code of Ordinance Sec. 12.08.030). It is unlawful for any person having made an excavation in any street, whether under a permit or otherwise to fail, neglect, or refuse to restore such street to its normal condition. **Street excavations shall have the surfacing replaced within three calendar days following completion of the excavation.** Before work permitted herewith is commenced, the applicant shall notify the American Fork City Engineering Department. Commencement of said work is understood to indicate that the applicant will comply with all instructions and regulations of the American Fork City Engineering Department with respect to performance of said work, and the applicant will properly safeguard said work to prevent accident and shall hold American Fork City free and harmless from all damages arising out of all operations performed under this Permit.

If the applicant fails to comply with the American Fork Engineering Department regulations, specifications, or instructions pertinent to this Permit, the City Engineer, or his duly authorized representative, may by verbal order suspend the work until the violation is corrected. If any gravel, dirt, or building materials are left on the street within the City, it must be cleaned up within 48 hours. If the applicant fails or refuses to comply promptly, the City Engineer, or his authorized representative, may issue a written order stopping all or any part of the work. When satisfactory corrective action is taken, a start order will be issued.

Applicant shall contact all emergency personnel, adjacent businesses, residents and Alpine School District. Provide adequate traffic control and call for inspection of all utilities, trench backfill and asphalt installation. **TRENCHES MUST BE COVERED WITH A STEEL PLATE AND NOT LEFT OPEN OVERNIGHT.** Concrete must be covered and heated, if required.

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Requirements/Special Instructions/Limitations:

Applicant shall provide the following:

- * Right-of-Way permit fee = \$150.00
 - Asphalt cut (per cut - 100 square feet) = \$200.00
 - Asphalt cut (per each additional 100 square feet) = \$40.00
- * A site plan showing cut location(s) with square footage and infrastructure installation including any handholds, manholes, and /or above-ground facilities
- * A performance guarantee in a minimum amount of two thousand dollars, plus five dollars for each square foot of replacement in excess of four hundred square feet or the anticipated roadway repair cost if greater as determined by the City Engineer (12.08.040). One half of the right-of-way excavation performance guarantee shall be released upon initial completion with the balance being held for one year as a durability retainer (17.9.200)
- * A traffic control detour plan.
